

2007 Harris Teeter Together In Education Milk Challenge Official Rules

Effective August 1, 2007 through May 31, 2008, these Official Rules govern the Harris Teeter Together In Education (TIE) Milk Challenge. Harris Teeter reserves the right to make changes to these Official Rules at any time. Please check www.harristeeter.com from time to time to ensure you are aware of any updates or changes. Your participation in the Harris Teeter TIE Milk Challenge indicates acceptance of these Official Rules.

Eligibility

The Harris Teeter Milk Challenge is open to any accredited public, private or parochial school that is participating in Harris Teeter's Together In Education school fund raising program, based on the 2007-08 TIE Rules and Regulations (rules can be found at www.harristeeter.com), containing any class with students from Pre-Kindergarten to 8th grade, within the Harris Teeter trade area that is organized and primarily operated for educational purposes. It is also available to accredited home school associations, containing any class with students from Pre-Kindergarten to 8th grade, in the Harris Teeter trade area and operated primarily for educational purposes and have 15 or more students.

Milk Challenge Rules

The Milk Challenge Program allows you to earn cash for your school by collecting caps from Harris Teeter Brand and Hunter Farms Brand half gallon or gallon containers of milk. Collect caps from Harris Teeter Brand and Hunter Farms half gallon or gallon milk containers which are designated with an "H" on the cap. Send your collected and washed milk caps to an enrolled school of your choice. Your school coordinator will submit collected milk caps to Harris Teeter for processing and verification. Each milk cap is worth \$.05.

Minimum and Maximum Fundraising Amounts

When the program is over, all participating schools will receive a check for the amount they earned. Schools must reach a \$25 minimum amount earned in order to receive a check. Each eligible school participating in the Harris Teeter TIE Milk Challenge may earn up to, but not more than, \$1,000 cash per TIE year (August 1, 2007 - May 31, 2008).

Payments

Checks will be made payable only to participating schools based on their registered TIE information for the 2007-08 TIE year. Payments to schools resulting from eligible milk cap submissions will be made twice each school year, on or about February 28th and June 30th. The February 28th payment will reflect the amounts earned from August 1st through January 31st, and the June 30th payment will reflect the amounts earned from February 1st through May 31st. Allow 3 to 4 weeks for checks to arrive.

School Coordinators

Each participating school must designate a school coordinator in order to be enrolled in the Milk Challenge program.

Program Changes

Harris Teeter reserves the right to cancel or alter the terms of the Milk Challenge program at any time.

Qualifying Products

Qualifying Milk Caps can be found on participating containers of Harris Teeter Brand and Hunter Farms half gallon and gallon milk containers which designated with an "H" on the cap. For a complete list of participating products visit www.harristeeter.com.

Redemptions and Program Deadline

To redeem qualifying milk caps for cash, a school must complete an official Milk Challenge Submission Form and enclose the form with each shipment of qualifying Harris Teeter Brand and/or Hunter milk caps. Submissions must be postmarked by January 31st for earnings to be included on February 28th checks and by June 8th to be included on June 30th checks. Schools are free to send milk cap shipments at any dates between these and Harris Teeter will keep a rolling total until the January 31st and June 8th deadlines. All submissions are subject to verification. **Milk caps should be sent to the following address: Harris Teeter TIE Milk Challenge, 701 Crestdale Dr., Matthews, NC 28105.** Please make sure that you have completed the Submission Form and enclosed this with your milk cap shipments.

Unacceptable Submissions

Milk Caps that have been defaced, mutilated, forged or in any way altered will not be accepted, nor will any caps from other products such as orange juice or water or from other retailers. Milk caps must be washed and packaged in groups of 100's.

Shipping Charges

All postage and shipping charges are the responsibility of the sender.
